With support of Batterers Intervention Committee (BIC) of Ohio Domestic Violence Network (ODVN), ODVN has just revised the Ohio Standards for Batterers Intervention. ODVN believes that batterers intervention programs (BIPS) must be a part of the coordinated community response to domestic violence that promotes safety for survivors, children, and the community. It is important that not only BIPs but also their community partners have deeper understanding of the Standards for Batterers Intervention.

In this first 2010 BIP regional training, participants will learn about what's new in the Standards, including a section on working with marginalized communities, such as immigrant/refugee, lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer (LGBTQ), women and others. The participants will also have an opportunity to explore how to apply the Standards.

BIP administrators/facilitators, victim advocates, probation officers, children services case workers, mental health service providers, and others interested in learning about the Standards are welcome to participate.
